

PRIVACY NOTICE ACCORDING TO ART. 13 EU GDPR 679/2016



I. Purpose of the data processing.

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This is information that is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but which by their very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users connecting to the site, the addresses in the Uniform Resource Identifier (URI) notation of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (success, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer environment. These data are used by us only to allow navigation on the website.

II. Cookie

Cookies are small text files that the sites visited by users send to their terminals, where they are stored to be re-transmitted to the same sites during subsequent visits. Cookies are used for different purposes, have different characteristics, and can be used either by the owner of the site you are visiting, or by third parties. This site does not use cookies for user profiling, nor are other tracking methods used.

Instead, session cookies (non-persistent) are used strictly limited to what is necessary for the safe and efficient browsing of the sites. The storage of session cookies in the terminals or browsers is under the control of the user, where on the servers, at the end of the HTTP sessions, information about cookies remains recorded in the service logs, with storage times no longer than seven days like other browsing data.

III. Methods of the data processing – Data retention

The processing is carried out in an automated way, with methods and tools aimed at guaranteeing maximum security and confidentiality, by subjects specifically appointed to do so in compliance with the provisions of EU Regulation 679/2016.

The navigation data do not persist for more than seven days (except for any need to ascertain criminal offenses by the judicial authorities).

IV. Data communication.

In addition to those who may be required to communicate by express legal obligation, personal data may be communicated, in compliance with GDPR, to those data processor who provide services for the computer system used by Sacma SpA. These data processor operate according to the instructions given directly by us.

V. Diffusion and data transfer.

Data are not diffused or transferred to non-EU territory.

VI. Complaints.

Users can lodge a complaint to the Privacy Authority in any case of unlawful violation of data.

VII. Rights of data subject.

Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 21 of EU Regulation 679/2016 accord to data subject specific rights like obtaining confirmation of the existence of their personal data and making them available in an intelligible form; users have the right to know the origin of the data, the purposes and methods of the processing, the logic applied to the processing, the identification details of the data controller and of the data processor to whom the data may be communicated.

Users are also entitled to obtain the updating, rectification, integration, deletion and limitation of the data, as well as the right to make opposition, for legitimate reasons, to the processing of the data.
